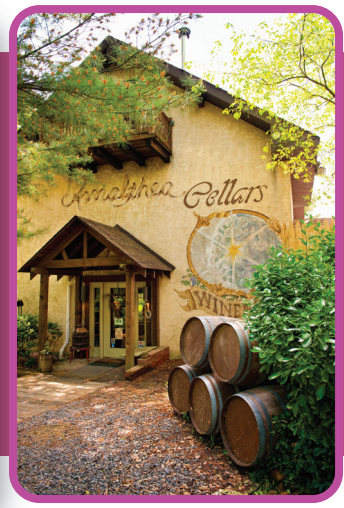
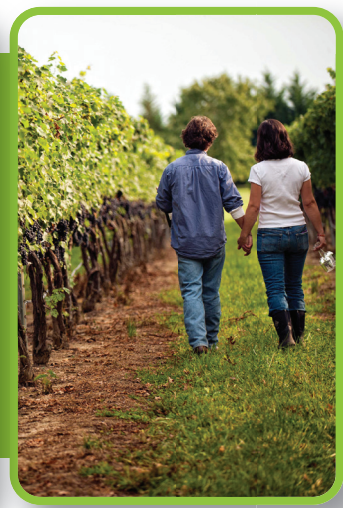

Listed here are just some of South Jersey's premier attractions. All are just minutes from Philadelphia, and close to transportation hubs and high-quality, affordable accommodations!

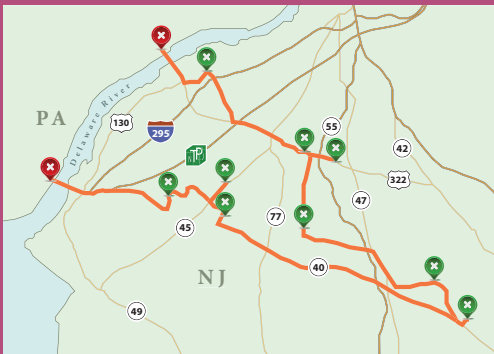

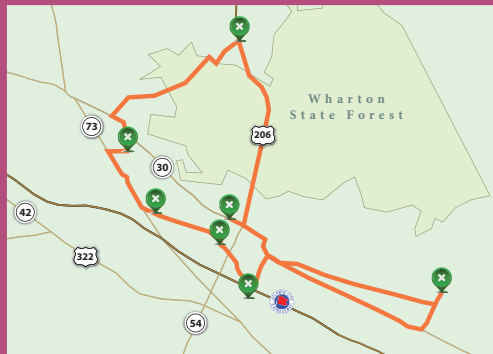
About South Jersey's Wine Region

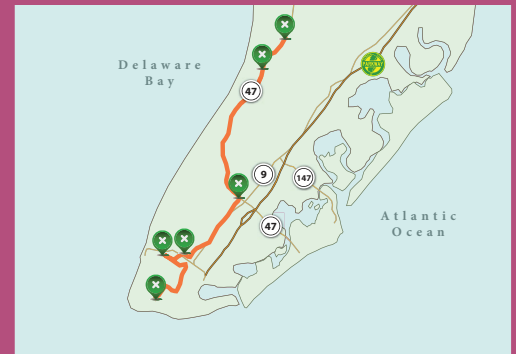
Wine Trails of the Outer Coastal Plain
