### Exhibits

#### In the Museum of American Glass

- **Ghost Optics:** Visitors to the Museum of American Glass will encounter a site-specific window intervention by guest artist and curator, [Jocelyne Prince](#). Her work, *Ghost Optics*, addresses early methods of flat glass and bottle glass production.
- **Portals & Passages:** Curator [Jocelyne Prince](#) has brought together five artists: Justin Ginsberg, Romina Gonzales, Ashley Raye Harris, Matthew Day Perez, and Alexander Wenstrup, who have an acute understanding of how just a few millimeters of glass can shift our perception of the world. Each work in this exhibition catalyzes the optical and sculptural space that exists within a sheet of glass.
- **Transformations: The Wasserstein Collection of Contemporary Glass:** The Museum of American Glass at WheatonArts is excited to unveil an unprecedented gift of almost 60 artworks selected from the Linda and Henry Wasserstein collection of contemporary glass. The Wasserstein's generous donation features work by the artists who first transformed glass

into a medium for functional, sculptural, and conceptual art, as well as those who are leading the field today.

### **In the Down Jersey Folklife Center**

- ***Communities and Cultures of Down Jersey:*** The exhibition offers a cross-cultural exploration of folk and traditional arts as associated with their ethnic, occupational and regional versions.

## **Group Information**

In addition to all of the many wonderful exhibits, demonstrations, and other attractions throughout WheatonArts, we offer special programs & classes for student and adult groups. At WheatonArts, we value the creative process and the many ways in which engagement with the arts introduces learning skills and strengthens basic classroom curriculum goals.

### **Student Group Admission is \$7.00 per student.**

Minimum ten (10) students. One adult is required for every ten (10) children. Additional adults, \$11.00 each.

**Adult Admission is \$11.00 per person for groups of 15 or more.** Add a private tour in the Museum of American Glass for an additional \$2.00 per person. The bus driver and group leader receive complimentary admission.

**Reservations should be made at least two (2) weeks in advance.**

**Deposit:** A deposit of 50% down is required. Final head counts must be made 5 days prior to arrival.

**Payment:** Payment is due in full on the day of your visit.

**Refunds:** We will refund your full deposit if cancellation is received two weeks before the reserved date. 50% of your deposit will be returned if cancellation is less than two weeks prior.

**Complimentary Policy:** The bus driver(s) and group escort receive free admission with 15 or more people.

**Transportation is not included.** If your group does not have its own transportation, please contact your local bus company or travel agent to make arrangements. Designated bus parking is available and is free of charge.
